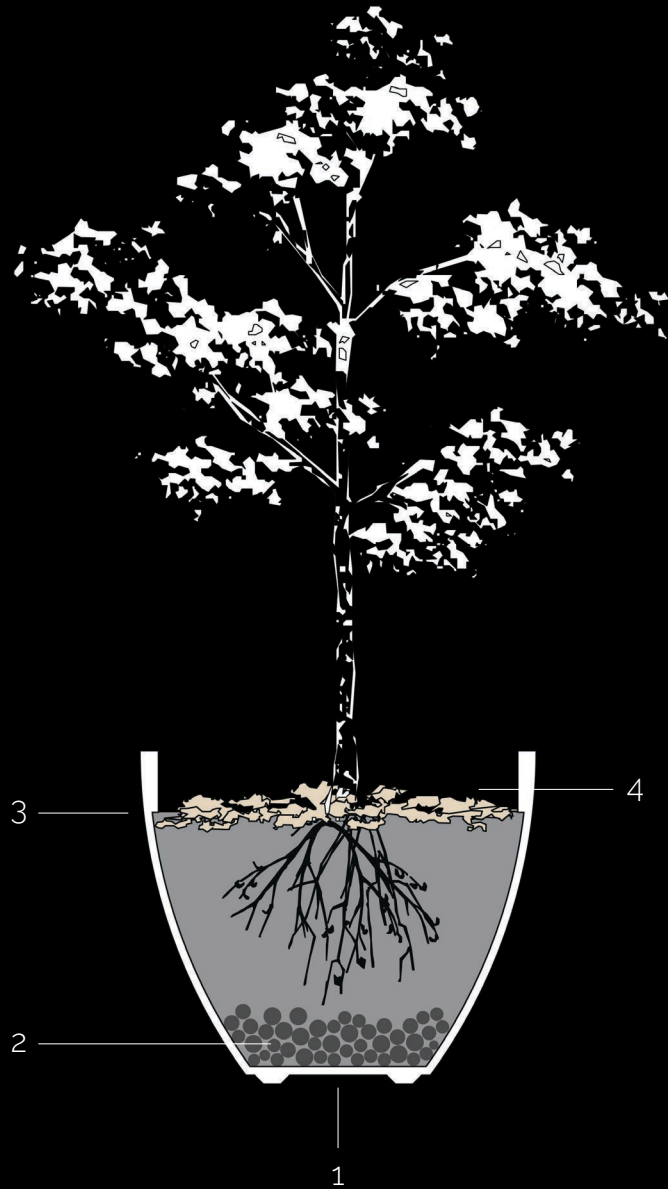


Planting Instructions



1. When used outdoors, drill holes every 12 inch of planter space in the bottom of the pot to allow for sufficient drainage. Use a 1 inch drill bit. The excess water can flow away along the raised bottom.
2. Add a layer of porous substrate of minimum 10% of the pot's height. Let a plant expert assist you in optimal watering management according to your planter's size and plant's specific needs.
3. Select the right soil for your plant and fill the pot. The bottom of the inner rim indicates the maximum filling height for an aesthetic result.
4. Cover the soil with bark chippings or similar decorative toppings to prevent weeds from spreading and wet soil from splashing up.
